Quality Manager

This position provides the leadership and direction of the quality maintenance system at the Montreal Service Center to ensure compliance to regulatory and GATX requirements. The Quality Manager participates and/or leads quality projects throughout the GATX Repair Maintenance network to continuously support our company's Strategic Initiatives.

Key Responsibilities:

- Coordinate the maintenance of the quality system and all of its processes and components to ensure that the repair performed in the facility satisfy all given customer, regulatory, and company requirements;
- Train Repair Center employees on Quality Processes and Procedures and maintain our training database;
- Audit Quality control documents (manuals and programs) and communicate documents pertinent to the quality system to all affected personnel;
- Analyze and communicate customers' rejects to all appropriate parties; establish and implement reduction plans based upon a root cause analysis to satisfy Maintenance Group's Initiatives;

- Serve as the technical liaison for researching, analyzing, and communicating quality related issues to regulatory bodies and GATX Rail Leasing and Maintenance functions;
- Oversee the audit process at the facility, including AAR audits, internal audits, process audits, and Field Operations audits, in order to continuously improve all aspects of the quality process;
- Manage the Inspection Department daily metrics and promote a culture focus on proactively identifying quality problems and implementing appropriate and lasting solutions;
- Assist with vendor approvals & perform vendor audits as required.

Education and/or experience required (including certifications):

- Bachelor's degree with concentration in Mechanic, Metallurgical, Welding, Engineering or related field or equivalent training;
- Minimum of 3-5 years of experience in quality assurance preferably in a unionized environment;
- Proven experience in a production/ manufacturing environment or in railcars maintenance;
- Understanding/experience in the following key processes, industry standards and operational best practices or willing to take the required courses and trainings:
 - CWB (Canadian Welding Bureau)
 - Weld Visual Inspection and NDT
