SECTION MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

PLAY BY PLAY

GOALS OF THE SMP PROGRAM:

- o Make the most of Section resources.

- o Promote and focus project participation.
- o Provide recognition for improvement.

Below is a summary of the requirements your Section must do to complete each Level.

To reach LEVEL 1:

- o Submit officer information by May 1st.
- o Submit committee chairs and financial report by August 1st.

To reach LEVEL 2:

- o Mail samples of all Section activities and successes to the Regional Director for onward transmission to ASQC Headquarters.

eg. Information on Training, Minutes of Meetings, Newsletters, Annual Budget, and Conferences.

To reach LEVEL 3:

- o Submit information on other activities such as the sponsoring of conferences, seminars, membership drives, scholarship funds or joint meetings with other associations.

To reach LEVEL 4:

- o This level is achieved based on the number of points allocated for each of the above Level 1 to 3 activities. There is still the Sadoris and Berg section classifications based on membership size. Your Section, with 400 members, is in the Sadoris competition.
