April's Meeting

For the years 1989-90 the section won the ASQC Section Management Plan For Achiever's award. The award is given to sections who have shown leadership in promoting the objectives of ASQC. To earn the award the section must offer a complete program to members, have a sound financial base and reach out to other organizations and the community.

For the member's program the section has monthly meetings and an annual event during October month, quality month. Topics for meetings range from plant tours to seminars.

The section works regularly with other professional organizations in the Montréal region. To reach out to the community the section works with Concordia University and Ecole de Technologie Supérieure on education. The section is also involved in the koality kid program; the aim of the koality kid program is to promote self confidence in children through improving their reading skills.

At the April 10 members meeting, Mr. Ridgely Park, Vice Chairman Section affairs came to Montréal and presented the award to the section. Debbie Deslauriers, past chairperson, received the award.

Mr. Park's address was on Integrated Management and Process Validation. The Food and Drug Administration Agency requires manufacturers of medical products to validate their processes before products are manufactured. FDA wants companies to ensure processes are fully understood and in control before manufacturing starts. In the past manufacturers have relied on inspection to ensure products were at an acceptable standard. Inspection frequently proved little use in assuring the quality of the product. For example: testing of sterile products was unreliable since bacteria would grow while the test was being done. The validity of the test would therefore no longer be an issue. Some testing would still be needed but it would be much less extensive than in the past. Most testing would be aimed at ensuring the process to be in control to assure that high quality products would be consistantly produced. FDA would thereby assure consumers have safe high quality products.

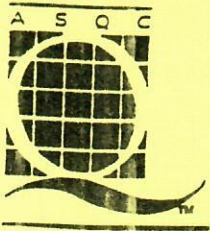
