Many companies are now advertising that they have achieved a given ISO level. To be able to say this is a good advertising plus, but be careful of those companies that feel once they have achieved ISO, it means their products are fully acceptable.

I recently read two advertisements. One read "You no longer have to audit us. We have ISO 9001." The other read "Now that we have our ISO accreditation, you no longer have to inspect our product."

Unfortunately, both statements are improper, and the product may still require inspection. ISO does not over rule auditing your suppliers and inspecting their products.

The purpose of the ISO Committee is to try to answer your questions, or advise you when certain information is available. 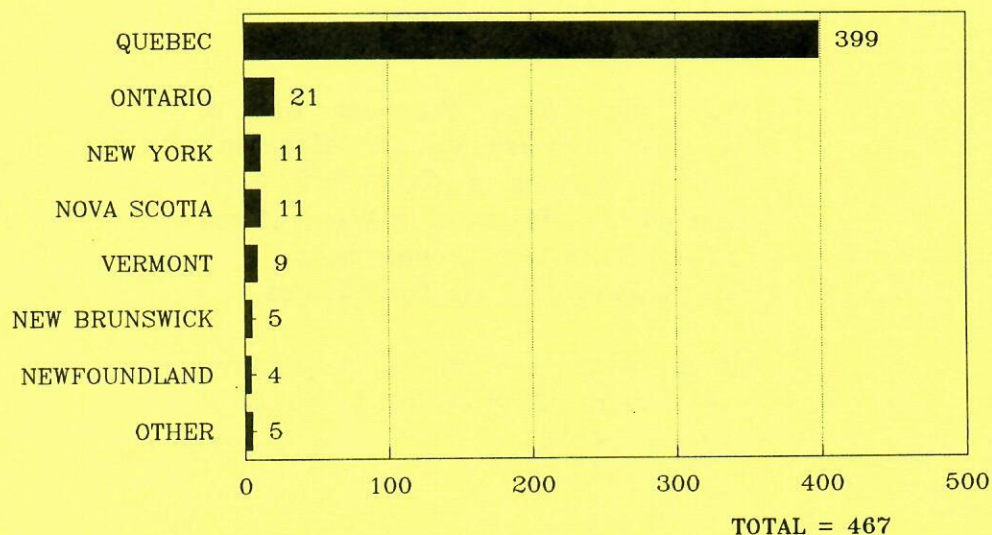
